#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

On the Wednesday before the first Sunday of Lent, the faithful people receive the ashes and so entering into the time established for the purification of their souls. This sign of penance, a traditionally biblical one, has been preserved among the Church's customs until the present day. It signifies the sinful condition of the human nature, who seeks to express guilt (need to repent) before the Lord in an outward manner, and by so doing expresses a desire for interior conversion, led on by the confident hope that the Lord will be merciful. This same sign of ashes marks the beginning of the way of conversion, which is developed through the celebration of the sacraments of Penance during the days before Easter." Have we have lost sight of he need to repent, the need to pray and the need to do penance. Many have abandoned these most precious elements of our redemption. Who said we don't need to pray earnestly and constantly. Prayer is the breath of your spiritual life. Refusing to pray is refusing God's presence. Who said we don't need to confess our sins regularly? It is self deception! Jesus began His public ministry with the message "repent and believe" Who said we don't need to do penance? It is ingratitude and pride. Who said there is no temptation in our world or lives? It could only have been the powers of darkness. Who said the Ten Commandments are obsolete? Falsehood must have spoken into confused Christian hearts. Nobody ever became a swimmer by dipping the toe in the water. As a faith people we need to go way beyond toe-dipping in the waters of our faith practice. We need to stand beneath the waterfall of God's merciful love. We also need to pray that we may see. We need to pray to be courageous. We need to pray for faith and direction. Prayer will bring God and His plan into view. We need to pray that God will empower us. This is God's season. Jesus in the desert. We celebrate His victory over temptation, the devil and darkness in the desert.

By making prayer a priority, silent reflection a daily practice, Confession a must, Holy Eucharist weekly or more, may you and every Parishioner rediscover the joy of being redeemed by Jesus Christ who truly loves us.
