GOSPEL - ROOTED

Vice-President George Bush attended the funeral of Soviet leader Leonid Brezhnev in Moscow. He saw Brezhnev's wife move to the casket just before they closed the lid. There, in that citadel of atheism, Bush was deeply moved as she leaned over the casket and made the sign of the cross on her husband's chest. In that simple gesture, she denied much of that for which her husband had stood, but it seems unlikely that she intended her gesture to be negative--hostile--a rejection. Rather, it would seem that she was reaching down to the depths of her being and her past to

bring up a bit of faith with which to grace her husband's leaving. Hers was not a gesture of disrespect, but of faith. In a time and place where faith was not allowed, she signalled that faith was alive. In a time and place where people hoped that the state would save them, she expressed her hope that God would save them. Hers was the faith that there was hope, even for her husband. It is that kind faith against the odds--that kind of hope against hope--to which Jesus calls us in the Parable of the Sower.
