GOSPEL - ROOTED

Today's gospel. A parable for our time, our people and our tomorrows.

The story of the coexistence of wheat and darnel in the same field and season.

The coexistence of God/good and the devil/evil in our place, among our people and in our time.

THE INTERPRETATION OF THE PARABLE

Those who sows the good seed = the children/people of Man (v. 37).

The field = = the world (v. 38).

The good seed = = the children of the Kingdom (v. 38).

The weeds = = the children of the evil one (v. 38).

+ The enemy = = the devil (v. 39).

The harvest = = the end of the age (v. 39).

The reapers = = the angels (v. 39).

The parable...is therefore a comforting word to all who daily build a personal relationship with God....those who seek out His ways and follow... those who love, help and support the neighbour for the love of God.

This parable ...is therefore a warning to those who daily ignore God personally, avoid His ways and teaching and ignore the needs of their neighbour. The story of the weeds helps teach us how to let go of our hurts. Sometimes we become so angry and sad when injured that we think of nothing else. We are consumed. We consider ways we can "get even" with the person who hurt us. The Bible tells us that God knows the "wheat people" those who want to do God's will and "weed people" those who hurt others. God will deal with the "weed people" and bring them to justice. So, let go of our burning to "get even" knowing that God's job is to make all things right. Daily = pray for those we know who are so wounded, unjustly!
