Word of God

'A prophet is only despised- in his own country among his own relations and in his own house' (v. 4). By applying this proverb to himself, Jesus implies that he is, indeed, a prophet, and that the people of Nazareth are guilty of rejecting him as the people of Israel have so often rejected the prophets. He is amazed at their lack of faith (v. 6). This raises the question of the relationship between faith and healing. Does Jesus refuse to heal unbelievers--or is his power constrained in the presence of unbelief--is he unable to heal unbelievers? In short the Gospel tells us that Jesus comes to bless us with his presence, and we must choose whether we will really see him and experience his blessing--or not.
