GOSPEL MATTERS!

Some Pharisees and Scribes asked Jesus: "Why do your disciples eat without washing their hands?" Jesus answered "It was of you hypocrites that Isaiah so rightly prophesied in the passage of scripture: "This people honour me only with lip-service while their hearts are far from me. They worship they offer is worthless and their teachings are only human regulations." Jesus tells us that the heart matters – it matters a lot. We ourselves regularly judge by the heart. We say "s/he has no heart" or "a cold heart" or "a hard heart" or "s/he has a heart" or "a warm heart" or "a soft heart" We judge a person's commitment saying "his heart is not in it" or "she is only half hearted" Again "s/he is wholehearted" when sadness or grief strike we say "her heart was broken" or "he went with a heavy heart" or "her heart overflowed with joy" or "she went with a light heart" and so on...... It is notable that the Scribes and Pharisees had great concern for clean hands and unclean hands. This is all about outward show. It is something we need to always struggle with. We can only offer fitting worship to God from our hearts and with all our hearts. Heart-some worship is an expression of our love for God and our need for Him. Heart-some worship is the foundation of Christian living
