There is a brief welcome for Jesus but they continue in their own ways.

They grumble about "their lot in life" and find someone to blame.

They ask God to bless and help them to do their will.

Using God as their convenience.

In the same family we have Mary, a very different sister

She appears **present and attentive** to the visitor Jesus.

Her **welcome is a very complete and assuring.**

She sits down at the feet of Jesus **giving Jesus her full attention.**

She listens to what Jesus has to say, to His teaching and advice.

Mary is putting Jesus first in her life.

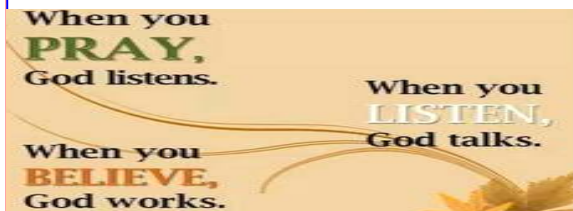
