#### 30th June 2019

Hello. How are you? From reading today's Gospel I was drawn to the following reflection: 'The cost of Discipleship':

Okay, let's take everything you know and turn it upside down. for starters, the FIRST will be LAST and the LAST will be FIRST. (Matt 20:16) Next. whoever wants to SAVE their life will LOSE it, but whoever LOSES their life for Jesus, will SAVE it. (Matt 16:25) Here's another twist - Monday 22nd July: 7.30pm Mass of Thanksgivwhoever chooses to be HUMBLE like a kid, will be the GREATEST in God's kingdom. (Matt 18:4) Are you catching a theme here? Are you ready to be a part of this UPSIDE DOWN kingdom? A kingdom of the LIVING DEAD, (Rom 6:11) A kingdom of SERVANT LEADERS, (Matt 23:11) of ROARING SHEEP. (Matt 10: 16) Jesus is looking for followers who will commit without looking back. This commitment may get costly it did for His first DISCIPLES. In Acts we first see Steven pay with his life. (Acts 7: 54-60) Then one by one came the beatings, the stonings, the jail time, death – but these DISCIPLES wouldn't LET UP, BACK UP, or SHUT UP! (Acts 12:2, 16:22, 23) Now the torch is passed to you: Are you ready to LOSE what you cannot KEEP in order to GAIN what you cannot LOSE? (John 10:28) Can you LEAD by SERVING, (Matt 20:28) Can you LIVE by DYING? (Gal 2:20) Are you ready to be a DISCIPLE OF CHRIST? Are you ready to turn your world UPSIDE DOWN? (Matt 5:16)

## **Celebrating St. Oliver Plunkett**

As part of the celebrations to mark the 350th anniversary of the appointment of St. Oliver Plunkett to the See of Armagh the Archbishop is inviting the people of the Archdiocese to do a pilgrim walk in honour of St. Oliver Plunkett. It will begin on Sunday July 7th at St. Peter', Drogheda, the shrine of the relics of St. Oliver Plunkett. It will wind its way north through different villages and towns associated with the life and ministry of the saint until Tues. July 9th when it will arrive in Armagh for the great unveiling of the new statue of St. Oliver honouring him and the martyrs of yesterday, today and tomorrow. The length of the walk is about 100km but it will be done in 10km relays. You can join it at any of the relay stations. On Monday 8th July the walkers will begin at 10.30am from Ardpatrick church near Louth village and will pause for prayer at St. Mary's Church Knockbridge and arrive at Ballybarrack for a prayer service at 12.30pm.
